Clinical Care Services

Assistance with wound care and incontinence

Personal Care Services

Support with showering, bathing, toileting and grooming

Transport Services

Help with shopping, visiting health practitioners and attending social events

Meal Preparation

Aid with preparing meals and eating

Medication Support

Assistance with medication management

Domestic Assistance

Support with domestic tasks, such as light cleaning and shopping for essential items

Social Support

Assistance when out in the community, such as accompanied shopping or GP visits, or support attending events, as well as daily phone calls, welfare checks and companionship

Cleaning or repairs for your health, safety, and accessibility including flooring and pathway repairs to address slip trip hazards, yard maintenance, and light gardening.
