Our 61-bed home offers 'ageing in place' across its two traditionally designed buildings, called Palmer and Thorne. Both feature sun-protected outdoor entertainment areas for eating, relaxing, and connecting with the outdoors.

AQ staff are specially trained in delivering holistic dementia care, enabling our residents to continue to lead an active and socially engaging lifestyle.

Activities

Residents can choose to participate in a range of group and individual activities, including cooking, music programs, art appreciation, art classes, and flexibility and fitness sessions.

Our wellness and enablement approach is reinforced by offering our residents access to a range of professionals, including 24-hour registered nurses, dentists, a physiotherapist, exercise physiologist, speech pathologist, occupational therapist, dietician, music therapist, and podiatrist.

Accommodation fees

Shared rooms require a maximum refundable accommodation deposit (RAD) of \$400,000, or maximum daily payments (DAP), or a combination of both apply.

Single rooms require a maximum refundable accommodation deposit (RAD) of \$550,000, or maximum daily payments (DAP), or a combination of both apply.
